TOTAL: 7,038 (15% of total EMS calls)


- 30% Low Acuity (2,113)

 - All Calls for Service: 60%
 - LTCs: 85%
 - Accounts for 21% of Total Transports

Problematic Trends




- Defensive 911 Activation

Problematic Trends




- Behavioral Health

Patient Impact



- "Transfer Trauma"³
 - Mood, Behavioral and Physiological Changes
 - Related to Stress of Unfamiliar Surroundings
- Increased Risk of Medically Induced Harm
 - Information Loss through Multiple Turnovers
 - Interruption of Continuity of Care
 - ED Boarding

Operational Impact



- Acuity/Resource Mismatch
 - Low acuity Non-emergency Ambulance/Van
 - Highest acuity Critical Care Ambulance
- System Readiness
 - Hospital Overcrowding/Delay in Handoff
 - Delayed Response Times
- Provider Burnout

Current growth of population 65+ is unprecedented in U.S. History⁴

• Cause: Baby boomer generation (1946-1964) In 2020, 1 in 6 were 65 or over in U.S.⁵

Drug Overdoses

Preliminary data for 2024 (as of September 2025) show a 43% decrease in overdose deaths in Virginia residents compared to 2023:6



Substance Use Disorder is making it ways into Long-Term Care (LTC) facilities as residents are aging. Henrico had a drug overdose in an LTC this year. Liaised with our Peer Recovery Specialist. REVIVE education for staff through DBHDS is encouraged.⁷


